The player and guardian must agree to the Code of Conduct as a condition of membership with Eston Minor Sports. At the start of each season, each of the participants must sign this Code and submit it to the player's head coach prior to the beginning of the season. Failure to abide by this Code of Conduct may result in suspensions or other actions from the Eston District Recreation Committee.

Player Code of Conduct

I will:

- Respect my coaches, teammates, officials, opponents, and volunteers
- Refrain from using foul language towards coaches, teammates, officials, opponents, and volunteers
- Maintain self control at all times
- Exhibit a high degree of sportsmanship, teamwork and positive attitude at all times when representing my team and the Town of Eston
- Respect the facilities, either home or away
- Accept the capabilities of other players
- Accept defeat with positive attitude and high degree of sportsmanship
- Be present for games and practices in a timely manner
- Notify head coach of any absences ahead of time

Guardian Code of Conduct

I will:

- Support my child and their teammates with positive encouragement
- Ensure my child attends all games and practices or notify the head coach of any absences ahead of time
- Show respect to coaches, athletes, officials, and volunteers
- Respect the facilities, either home or away
- Refrain from using foul language towards coaches, teammates, officials, opponents, and volunteers
- Refrain from yelling at or threatening referees, athletes, coaches, and other parents
- Refrain from approaching the bench during a game unless requested
- Accept defeat with positive attitude and high degree of sportsmanship
