

ANIMALS AT LARGE

Because of recent incidents, the Town of Eston will be using zero tolerance when enforcing the Animals at Large Bylaw. We understand that animals may accidentally get away (even the friendly, lovable animals) but in order to keep the community safe and treat owners the same, we will be adhering to the animal Control Bylaw (2021-03).

This bylaw gives the Town the authority to impound animals that are found running at large. If we can identify the owner of the animal from the Town of Eston tag, we will attempt to contact you. If we are unable to identify the owner from the tag, the animal's picture will be posted on social media as another attempt to identify the owner. Upon identification of the owner and the payment of the appropriate fine, the animal will be released back to the owner. If no owner is identified, the bylaw provides options including selling the animal.
