Civic Address Bylaw - January 2024



Coming into effect January 2024 - All houses and building will require a number. A uniform system of numbering houses and buildings is established and is shown on the tax roll. Each house or building shall bear the number assigned to the frontage on which the front entrance is situated.

House/building numbers will assist emergency personnel, service and delivery companies in locating a property.

Violation of this bylaw will be subject to \$150 fine.

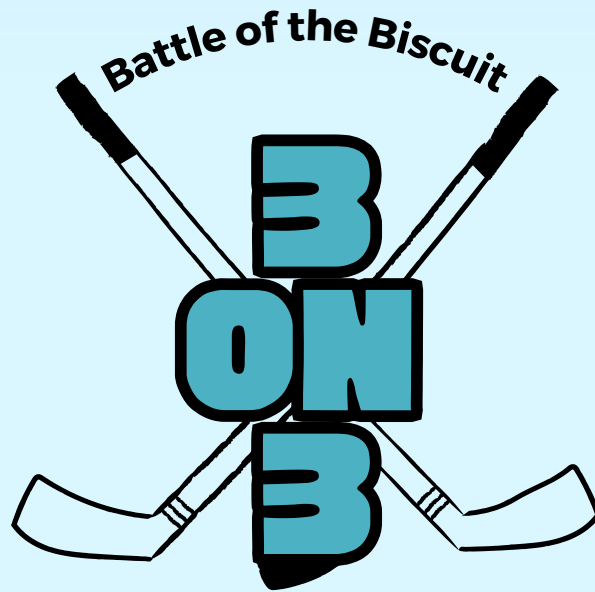
