Sidewalk Policy

The Town of Eston has established a policy to determine the longterm locations for sidwalks within the community. Where the sidewalk policy identifies sidewalks are to be kept long term, sidewalks will be maintained as budget and rsources allow. Outdoor Fire Policy

The Town of Eston has established a policy to ensure that outdoor fires in Eston are done with community safety in mind. Outdoor fires are permissible within Town limits. Should conditions become July 22-25-**Tiny Tales Time ages 3-5** -10am-12pm Eston Wheatland Library too dry, a fire ban will be put into effect. Outdoor fires must be Thu Aug 1 - Deadline for Hockey/CanSkate Registration contained within a non-combustible appliance constructed of material that is at least 16 gauge or 1/16" thick. 2024 Utility Rates

Utility rates have been approved by the Saskatchewan Municipal Board as required and will take effect June 1, 2024.

Water and sewer must be self-sustaining.

Water consumption is billed per 1,000 imperial gallons. As shown in the table below, these rates have not increased since January 2019.

The water rates at the Town stand are higher due to the infrastructure costs which are included in the water price, whereas in other parts of town, these costs are charged separately.

Each year, the Town will conduct a water cost analysis. Based on this analysis, and subject to Council's discretion and approval from the Saskatchewan Municipal Board, rates may be adjusted.

Infrastructure funding is allocated for both current and future water and sewer needs. This includes but is not limited to projects such as sewer lining, lift station maintenance, water treatment plant operations, and water line repairs.

These funds support ongoing operational requirements and also contribute to reserves for future.
